Strong's Marina- Sheila had conversations with Michael as to where the Town is going with RWB with covenants or the new marina zoning. Clayton Munsey sent letter to Janice & Michael.

Maritime museum- Continue RFP. Funding is slow going.

Solid waste- Stephanie talked about the new transfer fee, wording of 205, commercial landscapers must get permits. Tracking permit from DEC. She expressed that there might not be enough staff. CAC members expressed concerns that new fees will cause dumping on roadways.

North Sea Beach- Mark said that the public and private partnership of restoring the beach was a perfect timing. Reduced the costs associated with the project. Sand came from the west side of the channel. Dredging finished last Tuesday. Moving the sand will continue for a couple of weeks longer. Dredging of channel is a yearly event.
