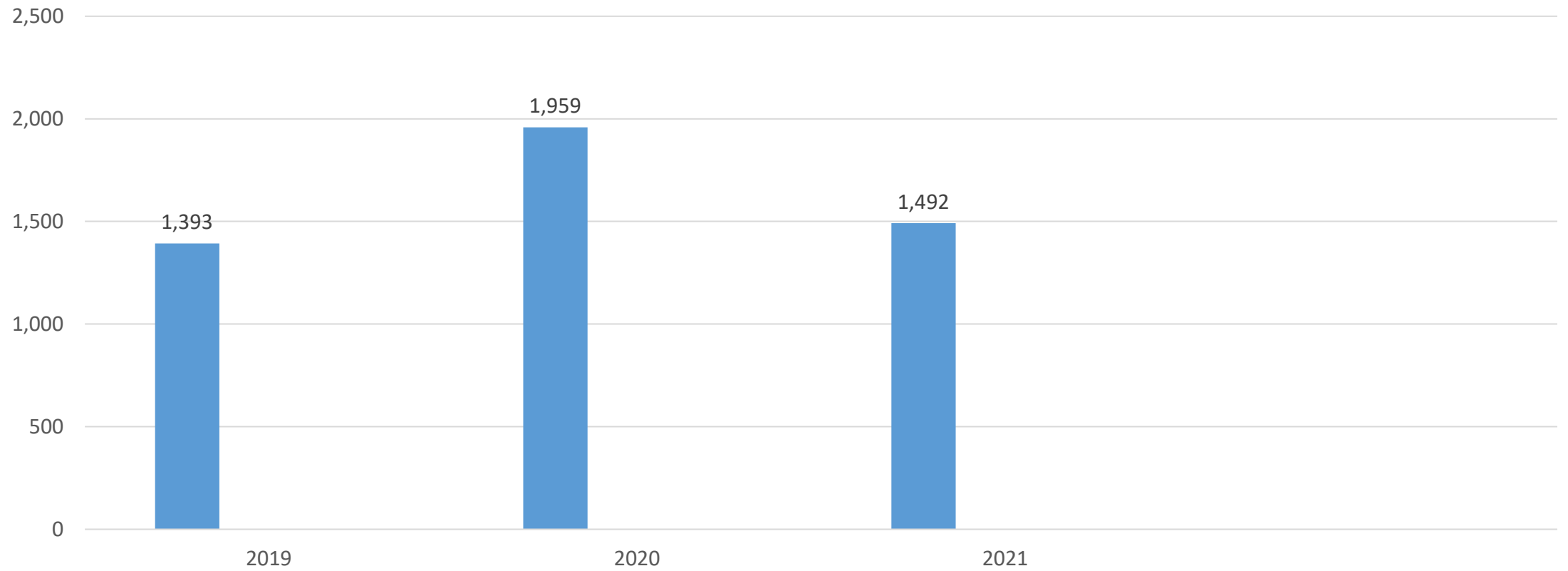

- Other assigned duties.



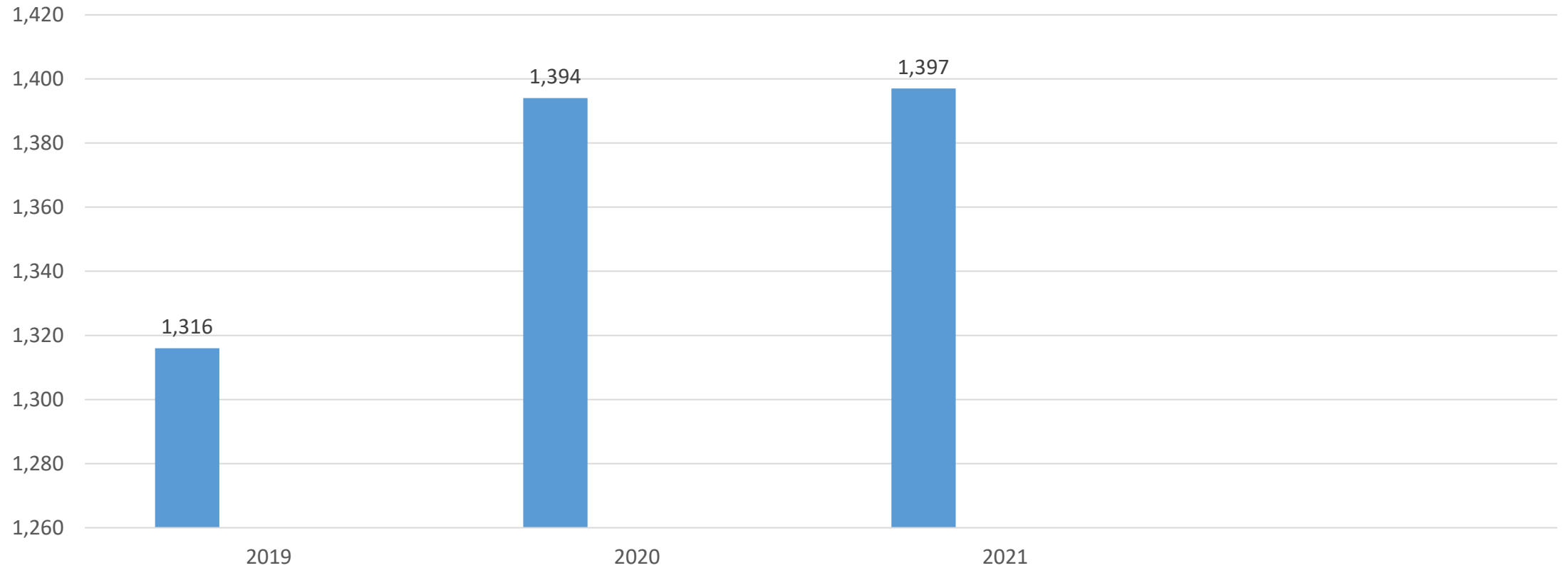
Rental Permit Stats

2019-2021 Rental Permit Applications



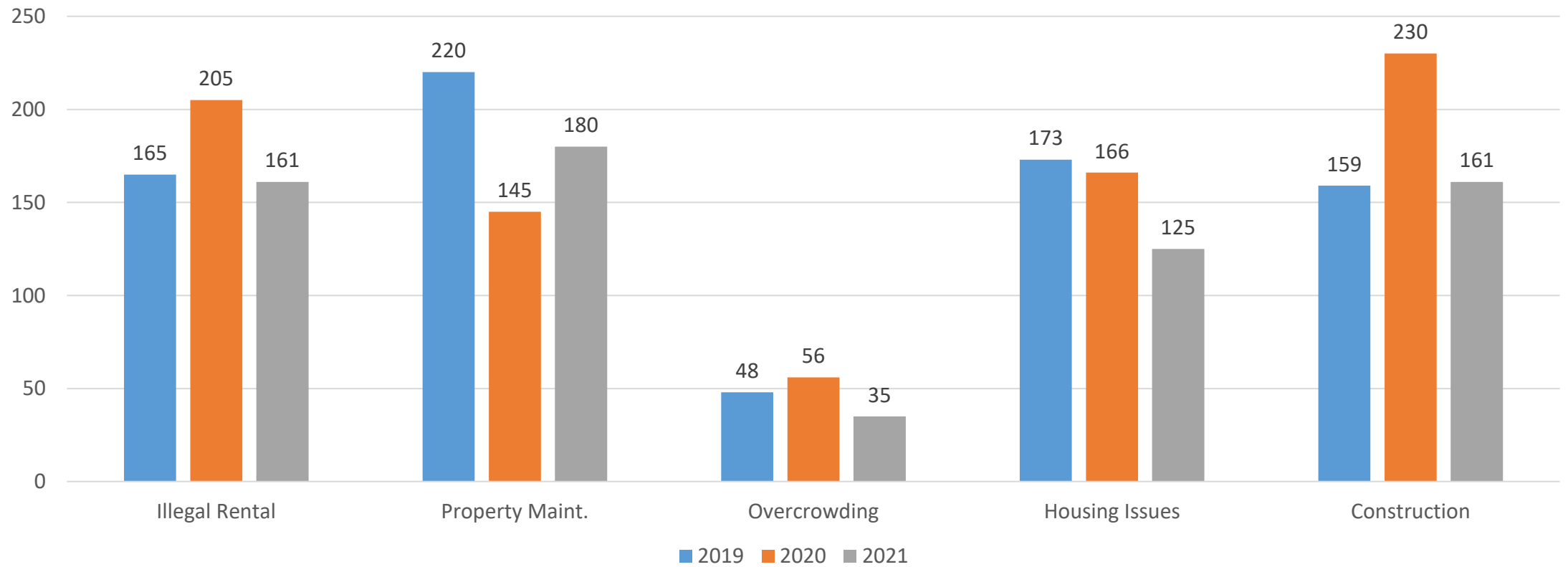

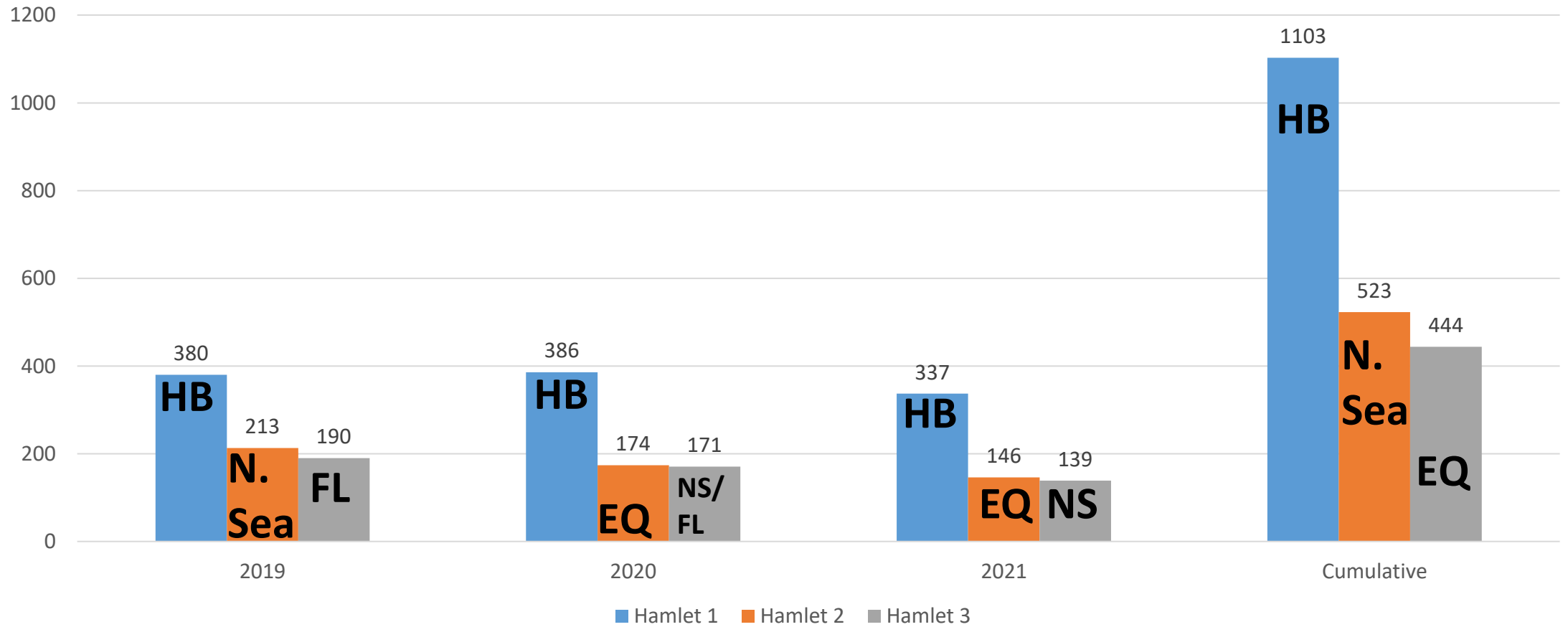

S.O.S Top Locations By Year



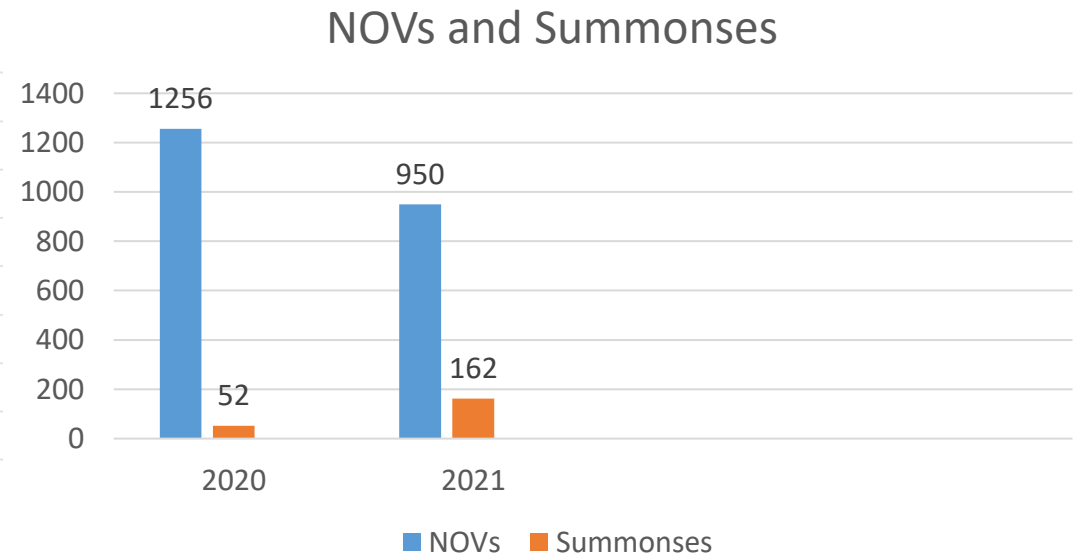
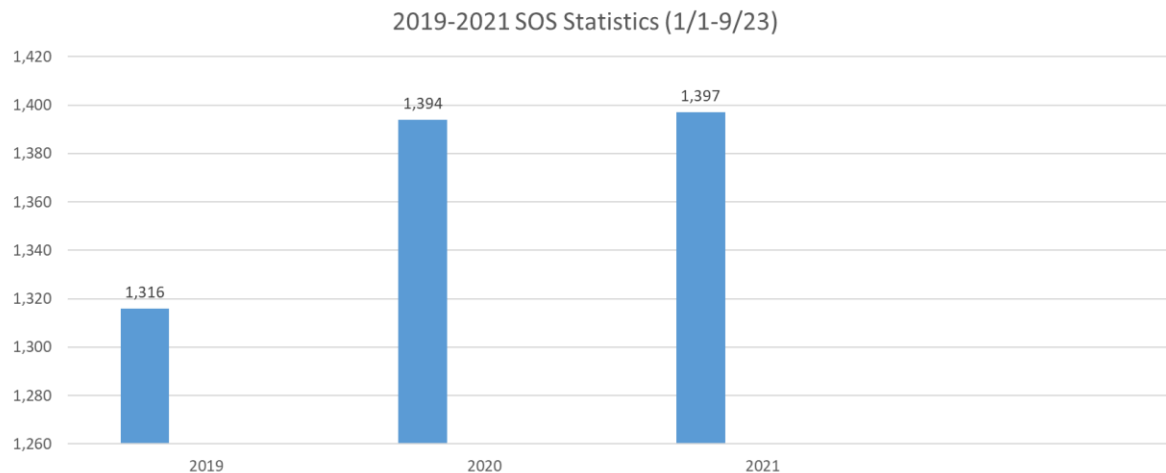
S.O.S. Statistics

In 2021 from 1/1/21 to 9/23/21 a total of 1,723 S.O.S. complaints or requests for assistance have been received by the Town. Of that total number, 1,397 of those complaints have been directed towards Code Enforcement for investigation.

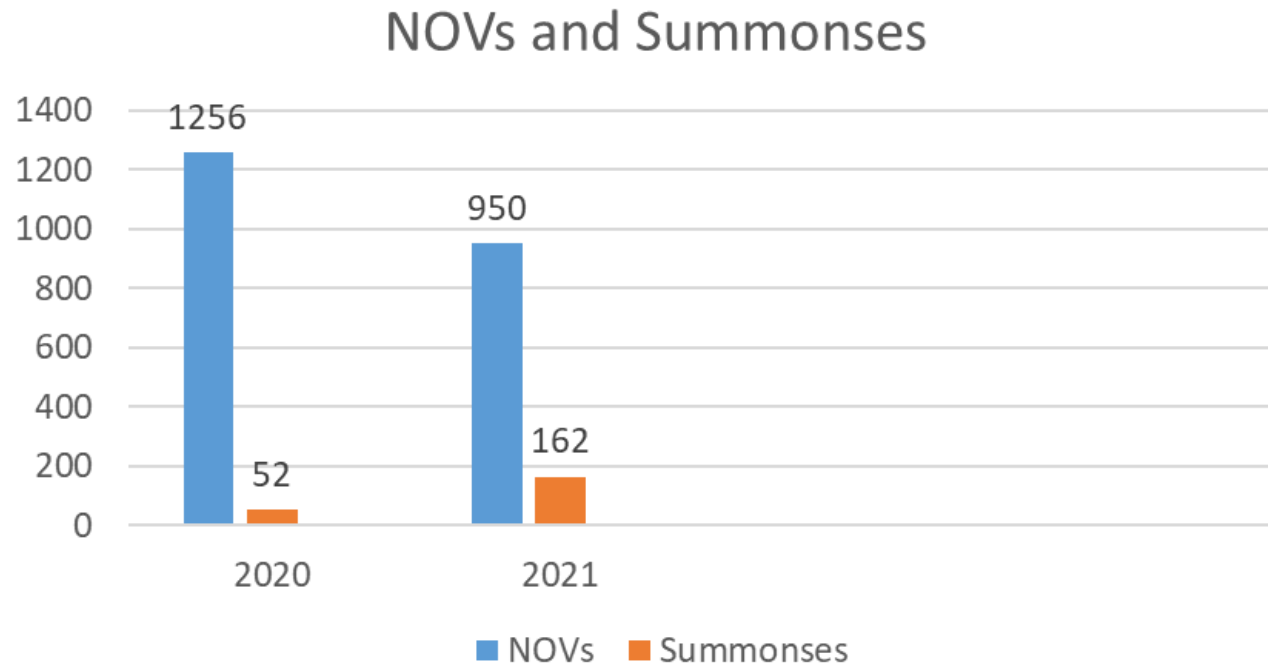
The majority of complaints that come in via the S.O.S. system are responded to by Code Enforcement throughout the year.

Enforcement

- Voluntary Compliance is our number one goal.
- Code Enforcement prides itself on educating and informing the public of the requirements of the NYS and Town Code in an effort to gain voluntary compliance.



Violations and Summonses



Of the S.O.S. complaints that come in, many result in at least a Notice of Violation being issued.

So far in 2021, about 17% of our violations have turned into summonses. This would mean that about 83% of the time we are able to gain voluntary compliance.

In 2020, due to COVID, as well as COVID associated Court closures, far fewer violations were progressed to the point of summons.

2021 Changes

- Shortened compliance periods on violations.
- Reduced attempts at trying to personally serve summonses.
- Increased use of Cease and Desist orders.
- Utilizing enforcement actions and forced cleanups when necessary to address some issues.
