

Study of Shinnecock's Fluke, movement pattern and use of the Bay

The **Shinnecock Bay Restoration Program**, in collaboration with the **School of Marine and Atmospheric Sciences at Stony Brook University**, is conducting a study of the Summer Flounder (Fluke) in Shinnecock Bay. Adult specimens will be tagged with acoustic transmitters. The acoustic transmitters are used to monitor their movement within the Bay.
