Hometown: Sag Harbor

Cook served in the 81st New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Mohawk Rangers," in Company H.

On November 22, 1861, at the age of 22, Edward mustered in to service with the rank of Private and was later promoted to 2nd Lieutenant.

Cook was wounded in action at Cold Harbor, VA. and was discharged for disability.
