## William Jones

Hometown: Unknown

Jones served in the 170th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the “4th Corcoran,” in Company K.

On October 7, 1862, at the age of 23, he mustered in with the rank of Private.

Jones was wounded in action on August 16, 1864, at the Battle of Deep Bottom, VA during the Siege of Petersburg, VA. He was discharged for his disability, June 12, 1865, at David’s Island, New York Harbor.
