Roe served in the 127th New York Volunteer Regiment, known as the
“Monitors,” in Company K.

On September 8th 1862, at the age of 42, he mustered in with the rank of
Private. He was wounded in action at Honey Hill S.C. on November 30th,
1864. He was later discharged for disability on March 15, 1865 at DeCamp
Hospital, David’s Island, New York Harbor.
